The Universities of Hannover, Braunschweig, Bremen, Göttingen, Halle, Lüneburg, Magdeburg, Oldenburg and Osnabrück invite to the **7th Bundesbank Workshop for Young Scientists**.

The workshop addresses young researchers from the participating universities in all areas of applied economic research. Graduate students, postdocs and junior professors have the opportunity to present their work and to network. The workshop will contain both oral presentations and a poster session with short pitches in the plenum.

A highlight will be two keynote sessions: We are happy that **Jens Ulbrich (Director General Economics, Deutsche Bundesbank)** will share his assessment of the state of the economy and related challenges for companies in Germany. A second keynote by a senior economist will cover a current topic in applied economic research.

Presenters have the chance to be awarded with the **Best Paper Award (500 Euros)** or the **Best Poster Award (250 Euros)**.

The workshop will be held in English. All presentations and posters will be accompanied by a discussion, and we expect all participants to take on a discussion. Travel and accommodation costs will be covered for accepted presenters (both papers and posters).

All those interested are cordially invited to attend the workshop, even without presentation (registration required). Participation is free of charge.
